



BEHAVIOR DICIPLINE/REWARD SYSTEM: I have a Bee Hive Bulletin Board set up with each child's name on a Bee. If a child misbehaves once, his "Bee" will be moved to a lower level in the hive. Twice- his bee is moved to the beehive door, and he will not be given a "Skittle reward" at the end of the day. Three times- his bee comes off the bulletin board hive, which means that he will not be able to get a sticker on his behavior chart at the end of the day or receive a "Skittle reward." So, good behavior will have a daily reward, and when each child's chart is filled with daily stickers, he will have the opportunity to choose a special prize from our Class Treat Box!

The daily calendar in each child's Take Home Folder is used as a means of informing the parents that their child has either had good behavior (he gets a bee stamp for each day), or that he has misbehaved, even if it's only once (he will not have a bee stamp in his folder for that day). **Disclaimer...it is possible that every once in a while I may forget to stamp the folders. ☺ That's why it would be a good idea to ask your child about their "BEE-Havior" each time there is a bee stamp missing.
